We are the only non-profit organization in the country whose goal is to promote the welfare of animals. Our mission is to be a voice for animals in Uganda, to promote the humane treatment of all animals, to prevent or suppress cruelty to all animals and to do all lawful acts in order to attain these objectives.

The USPCA envisioned accomplishment of its goal primarily through humane education in schools, public education through the local administration and promotion of free spay/neuter and rabies control clinics. Nevertheless the organization has further extended its services to; cattle transportation and slaughter, rabies control, animal rescue and adoption program by use of foster homes and newly opened office and kennel premises, controlling stray animals and offering free veterinary attention to the unprivileged animals. Working closely with the local administrators and other stake holders, the USPCA has gone an appreciable way in achieving its goal thus over the past 10 years the USPCA has rescued over 1000 animals, found adoption homes for over 800 dogs and cats, spay/neutered over 1600 dogs and cats, vaccinated and extended free veterinary attention to over 5000 animals and humane education to over 50 schools.
