April saw us having a very busy month, and some urgent repairs to the kennels being made , with big thanks to Karen and AKI for the donation towards this., and to Alex one of the Animal caretakers for giving up much of his own time to do them.

The repairs have made such a big difference, as now it is much more calm and peaceful to visit and the dogs are all less stressed, as there are far less fights.

We have also made a small area that separates the car park from the kennels, where the staff can let the dogs run out one kennel at a time, so they all have some exercise.

We also had a nice breakfast brunch and Easter egg hunt at Katch the Sun at the beginning of April, kindly hosted by Katch the Sun with prizes donated by Games Stores and Shoprite, which raised about \$400.

We have re-homed about ten dogs this month, but sadly not so many kittens. All Jane's fostered puppies have now found good homes.

The search for land still continues, but buildings go up on vacant land so fast, you have to grab it as soon as you see it—and we are not ready to do that!

We have completed several spays this month and taken in some very worthy needy cases from the streets. We urgently need some funds to do some spaying and also to continue the improvements to the kennels and exercise area at the Haven.

We are attending the ISU family fun day on May 7th , with some puppies and kittens, as the children there have been great in supporting us, as have all of our great volunteers .

Renzo, our friend in Europe, has raised funds with some of the children there, and one special lady donated her birthday present money to us, instead of having presents , so angels do exist.

And we have another social fundraiser planned for the end of May, details will be released once I have finalised them with the venue.
